

1. The first part of the document is a letter from the Secretary of the State to the Governor, dated the 10th of January, 1862. It contains a report on the state of the treasury and the public debt, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

2. The second part is a report from the Auditor General, dated the 15th of January, 1862. It contains a statement of the receipts and disbursements of the State for the year 1861, and a statement of the public debt.

3. The third part is a report from the Board of Education, dated the 20th of January, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the public schools, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

4. The fourth part is a report from the Board of Agriculture, dated the 25th of January, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the agriculture of the State, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

5. The fifth part is a report from the Board of Commerce, dated the 30th of January, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the commerce of the State, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

6. The sixth part is a report from the Board of Finance, dated the 5th of February, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the finance of the State, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

7. The seventh part is a report from the Board of Health, dated the 10th of February, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the health of the State, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.

8. The eighth part is a report from the Board of Education, dated the 15th of February, 1862. It contains a statement of the condition of the public schools, and a request for an increase in the tax on the sale of land.
