1836). The Mills, father and son, are also well represented: Einaudi had copies of the first, second and third editions of James Mill's *Elements of*



Political Economy (1821, 1824 and 1826), and twenty titles, many of them first editions, of works by John Stuart Mill, including the *Principles of Political Economy* of 1848 and *Unsettled Questions* (1844). A further important collection of books are works by eighteenth- and nineteenth-century Italian economists which, with works by Beccaria, Verri, Gioja, Bosellini, Fuoco, Scialoja, Ferrara and other authors of note, is virtually complete.

Other rare works, which are of even greater interest to scholars of economic thought, include Gasparo Scaruffi's *Alitinofo*, which first appeared in 1582; Antonio Serra's *Breve trattato delle cause che possono far abbondare li regni d'oro e d'argento...*, published in 1613; and the first edition of Abbot Galiani's *Della Moneta. Libri cinque*, printed in 1751 (with the publication date erroneously given on the title page as 1750).
